With reference to your application dated 29/04/2026 and subsequent school inspection in this regard, I hereby convey the grant of Recognition to **JAIN PUBLIC SCHOOL KORBA** for **classes NURSERY to 12th** standard for the period of 1 (One) year from the academic **year 2026 to 2027** in compliance with Section 18 of the Right of Children to Free and Compulsory Education Act, 2009 and Rule **RTE 12 (1)(C) of Chhattisgarh State Education Rules.**

The above recognition is subject to the following conditions:

1. The temporary recognition accorded to the school is valid for the academic year 2026–2027 and is to be renewed at an interval of every 01 year.
2. The grant of recognition is available initially for classes i to viii standard and to be extended to secondary/senior secondary classes subsequently in due course of time.
3. The school shall abide by the provisions of the right of children to free and compulsory education act, 2009 and the rte (12) (1) c to education act, 2009 and Chhattisgarh state education rules. (State education act/rules).
4. The school shall admit in pre-school/class i at least 25% (%age) of the strength in each class, children belonging to weaker section and disadvantaged group in the neighborhood and provide free and compulsory education till its completion.
5. The school shall maintain a separate bank account for reimbursement purposes.
6. The school shall not collect any capitation fee and subject any child or his or her parent or guardian to any screening procedure.

7. The school shall not deny admission to any child:
 - a) For lack of age proof if such admission is sought subsequent to the extended period prescribe for admission
 - b) On the ground of religion, caste, race, or place of birth.
8. The school shall ensure that:
 - a) No child admitted shall be held back in any class or expelled till completion of elementary education.
 - b) No child shall be subjected to physical punishment or mental harassment.
 - c) No child is required to pass any board examination till completion of elementary education.
 - d) Inclusion of students with disabilities/special needs as per provisions of the Right to Education Act, 2009.
 - e) Teachers are recruited with minimum qualifications as prescribed under RTE Act 2009.
 - f) Teachers perform duties as specified under RTE Act 2009.
9. The school shall follow the syllabus based on curriculum laid down by the appropriate authority.
10. The school shall maintain standards and norms as specified in the RTE Act 2009.
11. No unrecognized classes shall be run within the premises or outside in the name of the school.
12. The school building plan must be approved as per current rules and government orders. The premises shall be used only for educational and skill development purposes. Construction work, if any, shall not be carried out during school hours, and safety measures shall be ensured by the management.
13. The school shall be run by a society registered under the Societies Registration Act or a public trust constituted under applicable law.
14. The school shall not be run for profit to any individual, group, or association.
15. The accounts shall be audited annually by a Chartered Accountant, and proper records shall be maintained.
16. The school shall furnish such reports and information as may be required by the competent authority from time to time and shall comply with such instructions of the State Government or the competent authority as may be issued to secure the continued fulfillment of the conditions of recognition or the removal of deficiencies in the working of the school.
17. 03 (THREE) language subjects shall be taught as subjects from Standards I to X in all schools notified under CBSE (concerned Act/rule) from the academic session for which recognition is granted.

18. The school shall abide by the provisions of the RTE Act, 2009 (State Act/Rules).
19. The certificate of recognition issued by the department shall be subject to the fulfillment of deficiencies, if any, pointed out by the department at any stage/time.
20. The management shall rectify the deficiencies pointed out in infrastructure or administration by the authorities within the stipulated time.
21. The management shall apply for renewal of recognition three months before the expiry of this order to the District Education Officer, Korba (C.G.).
22. The management shall follow the directions issued by the Government/Department from time to time, keeping in view the safety and security of the children and the overall administration of the school.
23. The recognition shall be withdrawn if any contravention of the provisions of the Act, Rules, or the conditions of recognition is found and proved.
24. The school management shall have full responsibility if any court cases arise in this regard. The management is not entitled to seek affiliation to any other Board without obtaining NOC from the State Government / School Education Department, Chhattisgarh (Concerned State Authority).
